

Dear Neighbors,

As you know, the board has adopted a policy for each home owner to provide his or her own water storage and re-pressurization system. This policy is anchored in the current Covenants & Restrictions as filed with Cherokee County for any new construction. Existing homes prior to this policy are exempt. However the board ***STRONGLY RECOMMENDS*** that existing homes add their own system too.

In order to make this as simple as possible we have provided all the information we believe you will need.

First you should probably look at the "water storage system" attachment. This is a schematic drawing of the way the tank would be installed inside crawl space or basement and will give you some idea of what items will be required, depending on where you have it installed. Most of these items will be standard for all installations meaning you do not have many big technical decisions.

Second, you should select a tank from the www.ntotank.com website. This is the main selection you need to focus on, where will this tank be located:

- a) Inside house, closet, garage, crawl space, etc.?
- b) Outside underground?

Consider installation/maintenance space as well as where your water line enters the house with electrical service available. In the event of a mechanical failure, where will the overflow go. As of this writing, the Green 400 gal and the Doorway 400 gal, 300 gal round and rectangular appear to fit most needs.

Third, review the picture attachments. This is the JET FLOW pump recommended by John Leder. This pump is made in the USA and is available in 240VAC models. You will need to decide if you are going to use an AC (electrical plug – so you could hook it up to an extensions cord and emergency generator during power outages) or permanently wire the pump.

The Example Material List attachment includes some out dated prices prior to any quantity discount, so that you can see an estimated cost for materials.
